

NC Board of PT Examiners Report at the NCPTA Business Meeting Marriott Greensboro Downtown, Greensboro, NC October 16, 2010 By Ben F. Massey, Jr., PT, MA, Executive Director

1. **Purpose of the Board:** The purpose of the Board is to regulate the practice of physical therapy in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of North Carolina. The next meeting of NC Board of PT Examiners is scheduled for Thursday, December 9,

2. **Appointments to the Board:**

The 2011 Ballots for appointment of one (1) physical therapist and one (1) medical doctor were mailed in late July with a return deadline of September 1, 2010. On September 22, 2010, Board Member Deborah Ragan submitted her resignation to the Governor, which opened up another position for a physical therapist on the Board to fill her unexpired term. The ballots were counted at the NCPTA Headquarters on September 10, 2010 and the candidates for appointment were forwarded to Governor Beverly Purdue on October 8, 2010.

- 3. <u>Continuing Competence:</u> Licensees who are in the First Reporting Period (2009-2010) will be required to complete their continuing competence on the Board's online reporting form prior to licensure renewal. Kathy Arney, Continuing Competence Consultant, has responded to more than 2,000 questions via email and telephone. Information regarding continuing competence is available on the Board's web site.
- 4. Online Renewal: Licensees are required to renew their licenses online. Postcards will be mailed prior to November 1, 2010 informing licensees that the renewal period will be open online from November 1, 2010 until January 31, 2011 at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and that online renewals will require a major credit card. Licensees not wanting to use a credit card will be given the option to renew online, but pay by check or money order. (The Board strongly recommends that licensees renew online by January 15, 2011 to ensure that it will be processed.).
 - 5. **Position Statements:** At its recent meeting, the Board updated several of its current Position Statements. In addition, the Board revised its Position Statement on Intramuscular Manual Therapy (Dry Needling). Position Statements can be located on the Board's web site.
 - 6. **Foreign Educated Physical Therapists (FEPT's):** Effective July 13, 2010, "in response to pervasive, ongoing security breaches by significant numbers of graduates of physical therapy schools from four countries", PT and PTA examinations have been suspended for graduates of programs in Egypt, India, Pakistan and the Philippines by the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy. 
