## Activities for Demonstrating Continuing Competence

DISCLAIMER: The Chart below was developed as a "guide" and to help clarify the Board's Rules for licensees seeking information regarding the requirements for continuing competence; however, it is not a substitute for the Rules themselves. To the extent that the chart may be inconsistent with the Rules, the Board's rules control decisions regarding the requirements.

Requirements:
Physical Therapists: Document 30 points in each 25 month reporting period.
Physical Therapist Assistants: Document 20 points in each 25 month reporting period.
All PT and PTA licensees must complete a jurisprudence exercise each 25 months that is equal to 1 point and will be counted toward the total.

Definitions:
One (1.0) CEU $=10$ contact hours
10 contact hours, 10 classroom hours or 10 Course hours= 10 points; Activity must be at least 50-60 minutes to earn one hour of credit.
